

BISHOP BUS PROTOCOL

- Do not be late for the bus. Getting to the bus stop five to ten minutes before the bus arrives prevents rushing.
- Stay ten giant steps away from the outside of the bus.
- Follow all safety protocols when walking to the bus stop or when waiting at the bus stop.
- Never engage in horseplay at the bus stop and never wait in the street.
- Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before approaching or preparing to get off.
- Wait for the driver to activate the red school bus lights. Be alert to traffic when crossing to or away from a bus to ensure that cars have stopped.
- Wait until the driver has given you the OK to cross the street or walk in front of the bus.
- Always sit properly on the bus. Avoid standing and obey the bus drivers /monitors instructions.
- No horseplay, shouting or yelling while getting on/off or riding on the school bus. Always be courteous and respectful of others.
- Avoid picking up any items you may have dropped near the bus. Instead ask the driver for help.
- Stay away from the wheels of the bus at all times.
- Keep all body parts inside the bus and never throw anything from the bus.
- Wait until the bus stops before getting out of your seat.
- Always be aware of traffic when getting on/off a school bus.
