

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The purpose of the School Committee in providing transportation assistance to students is to facilitate safe travel between home and school.

Transportation assistance is provided in two ways:

1. To special needs students, by means of the school system's own buses and vans and by means of contracted carriers.
2. To students who live outside the designated "walker" radius of the school attended, by means of tickets for use on public transportation buses. The cost of the tickets will be borne by the school system.

The Chief Financial Officer shall have overall responsibility for supervision of the transportation services to students.
