

TUTORING FOR PAY

By "tutoring" is meant the giving of instruction or help to an individual or group, for which the teacher receives payment other than through the School Committee.

Tutoring is not to be recommended by the Principal or other staff member unless the appropriate teacher of the student involved is consulted and agrees that it will be of real help. If tutoring seems advisable, the Principal, guidance staff, or department head concerned may give the parents a list of persons who are willing to tutor. This list may include teachers, but not the student's teacher of the subject in which he/she is to be tutored. The parent will be free to employ whomever he/she wishes.

Tutoring is not to be done in the school building.
