

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISIONMAKING
(Guidelines for Student Advisory Councils)

1. There shall be one student elected from the Arlington High School Student Advisory Committee (SAC) to serve in an advisory capacity as a non-voting representative to the Arlington School Committee, as delimited below.
2. The SAC advisory member to the School Committee shall not attend executive sessions.
3. The SAC advisory member to the School Committee may receive materials pertaining to agenda items dealing with the Arlington High School curriculum, physical plant, discipline programs (not specific cases), and similar items. Items dealing with personnel, evaluation of staff, and budget are not considered appropriate for student participation.
4. Decisions as to the appropriateness of materials to be made available to the SAC advisory member will be made by the chair of the School Committee and/or the Superintendent.
5. The administrative headmaster of Arlington High School shall be the principal adviser to the SAC, and as such the administrative liaison to this group. He/she will meet with the SAC regularly.
6. The SAC advisory representative to the School Committee shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Committee and shall observe the Code of Ethics of School Committees.
