

2011-2012 Income Eligibility Table and Full-Day Kindergarten Sliding Fee Scale

This is a blank income eligibility table and sliding fee scale that districts can fill-out and provide to families.

Determining family eligibility for reduced tuition: First, calculate a family's gross monthly income (to convert monthly income from weekly income, multiply by 4.33; to calculate monthly income from bi-weekly income, multiply by 2.17). Next, find the column with the family's size written at the top. Read down the column until you come to the correct monthly income, then read across to Columns C and D (monthly tuition is annual divided by 10) to determine a family's monthly and annual tuition. Payment schedules should be arranged accordingly.
