- I will not interfere with or stop other students from using school computers or programs.
- I will be responsible for my student folder and the work that is saved in it.
- I will not go into other people's folders or change their work without their permission.
- I understand that the use of the APS's technology is a privilege, not a right, and that inappropriate use or behavior that goes against the school Code of Conduct in the Elementary Handbook may lead to a loss of these privileges and/or other disciplinary actions.
- I release the APS from any liability that may result from my use of school technology, including use of the Internet.
