

Arlington Commission of Arts and Culture Seeks New Member

Town Meeting established a seven-member Cultural Commission which shall consist of Town residents, six appointed by the Town Manager, one by the School Committee. The Commission shall endeavor to preserve and promote the cultural and artistic resources in Town and work toward establishing Arlington as a significant cultural destination through promotion, education, advocacy, and related activities.

The commissioner would be required to attend one monthly meeting and to also serve on subcommittees with specific tasks related to the promotion of the arts and culture in Arlington. The commissioner should have knowledge of the Town of Arlington especially as it relates to the school system and be ready to advocate for a climate in the schools and in the town that encourages the growth of and accessibility to a broad range of artistic and cultural opportunities.

Grant writing skills would be a great asset to the ACAC.
